

## **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

SNOW GUARD PLACEMENT FOR SHINGLE STYLE ROOFS (Asphalt Shingle, Tile, Slate, Synthetics, Metal Shingle)


#### Less than a 6/12 Pitch

For roofs less than 6/12 pitch, the distance between the butt end and the pad face must be a minimum of 3x the thickness of the roofing material.




# Greater than or equal to 6/12 Pitch


For roofs greater than 6/12 pitch, the distance between the butt end and the pad face must be a minimum of 6x the thickness of the roofing material.




## **EXAMPLE PATTERNS: (Specified pattern and dimensions are dependent on individual roof characteristics.)**




TRADITIONAL SPREAD PATTERN

SNOW FENCE WITH SOLDIER ROW





# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS CONTINUED

#### **NEW ROOF**

- Follow recommended layout pattern for specific roof and snow situation following the Rocky Mountain Snow Guard Layout Guide.
- 2. Mark location of each snow guard.
- 3. Fasten snow guard with appropriate quantity and type of fasteners:
  - -ST / Yeti: Fasten through top 3" of strap. -RG: Fasten through fastening holes in strap.
- 4. Continue shingling roof.



## **EXISTING ROOF**

- Follow recommended layout pattern for specific roof and snow situation following the Rocky Mountain Snow Guard Layout Guide.
- 2. Mark location of each snow guard and apply appropriate sealent to shingle where fasteners will penetrate.
- Attach with 2 or 3 Woodbinder Eclipse #10 screws:
  - -ST / Yeti: Fasten through exposed strap.
  - -RG: Fasten through fastening holes in strap.
